**IOWA CITY, Iowa** - The International Headquarters of The Delta Chi Fraternity is aware of allegations facing the Delta Chi chapter at Sacramento State University stemming from photos and video that allegedly depict hazing. The operations have been suspended by both the University and the International Headquarters. We continue to work in partnership with officials from the office of Student Organizations and Leadership at Sacramento State to investigate these allegations.

While it appears the photos and videos that have been called into question occurred some years ago, we are continuing to investigate the circumstances. Together with the undergraduate students, University officials, and Fraternity professional Staff, we are committed to eradicating scenes and events like these from our Chapters, regardless of the intent.

Delta Chi is predicated on promoting friendship, developing character, advancing justice, and assisting in the acquisition of a sound education. Per our basic expectations, members will respect the dignity and worth of all persons, will protect the health and safety of all human beings, and will challenge all fraternity members to abide by these fraternity obligations, confronting those who violate them.

No undergraduate chapter or colony, nor any member or associate member, shall engage in the hazing of any person at any time. Hazing has no place in Delta Chi and is in direct violation of our values as a fraternity and our basic expectations. We take these allegations seriously and will continue to investigate the matter to reach a positive and proper outcome.
